



## SELECTION OF DOCTORAL RESEARCHERS

We will welcome up to 20 doctoral researchers at the Summer School, who are currently undertaking PhD research in the field of career guidance and counselling:

### Important dates:

- Early Registration (recommended): ASAP
- Registration Deadline: 15 February, 2019
- Results of selection: ASAP on receipt of application, and latest by 15 March 2019
- Payment to Summer School venue: by 15 April 2018
- Summer School: 9-14 June, 2019

### CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Evidence of enrolment as PhD students at a university.
- Relevance of the applicant's research project to the broad field of career guidance and counselling. Research from a social justice perspective is a bonus, but not a requirement.
- Efforts will be made to have as wide a representation of student backgrounds as possible, in terms of origin, university affiliation, gender, disciplinary background, and age.
- Where the short-listing of eligible candidates exceeds the number of vacancies available, the following criteria will be considered in making the final selection:
  - applicants' academic and professional publications
  - research or teaching experience related to career guidance
  - professional practice in the field, and
  - involvement in international research collaboration

**NOTE: Proficiency in English is necessary in order to benefit from participation in the Doctoral Summer School.**
