Selection Criteria

Selection of doctoral researchers for the Online ECADOC Summer School 2021

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Evidence of pre-enrolment, current enrolment or final stages as a PhD student at a European University.
- The applicant has demonstrated the relevance of their doctoral research project to the field of career guidance and counselling (broadly defined and to include the study of career from a variety of disciplinary perspectives).
- The applicant has supplied all the required documentation prior to the deadline for application.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Where the number of eligible candidates exceeds the number of places available, the following factors will be considered in making the final selection:

- Diversity in the make of the student group in terms of university affiliation, and disciplinary background.
- Diversity in terms of gender, ethnicity, nationality, and age.
- Evidence of applicants' academic contribution via scholarly engagement in publication, research, teaching, and international collaboration
- Evidence of applicants' professional engagement in career guidance and counselling
