Aim and objectives

To achieve this, the project aims to develop and pilot research-based educational training, as well as guidance and counselling for refugees and migrants from LAC countries to develop their potential to become active and productive members of society.

What do we want to do?

The project's expected outcomes involve a thorough and relevant comprehensive analysis and needs assessment of the challenges, obstacles and opportunities the target group faces in each participating country and a comparative study in order to successfully integrate to the recipient's country labour market. The main activities that the partnership will undertake are:

- Research study and situation analysis with the target group at the centre to project a current view of the challenges and opportunities.
- Using the needs assessment, training material will be developed and guidance for LAC will be offered.
- Publication and dissemination of the findings, as well as a continued learning and networking online platform.
